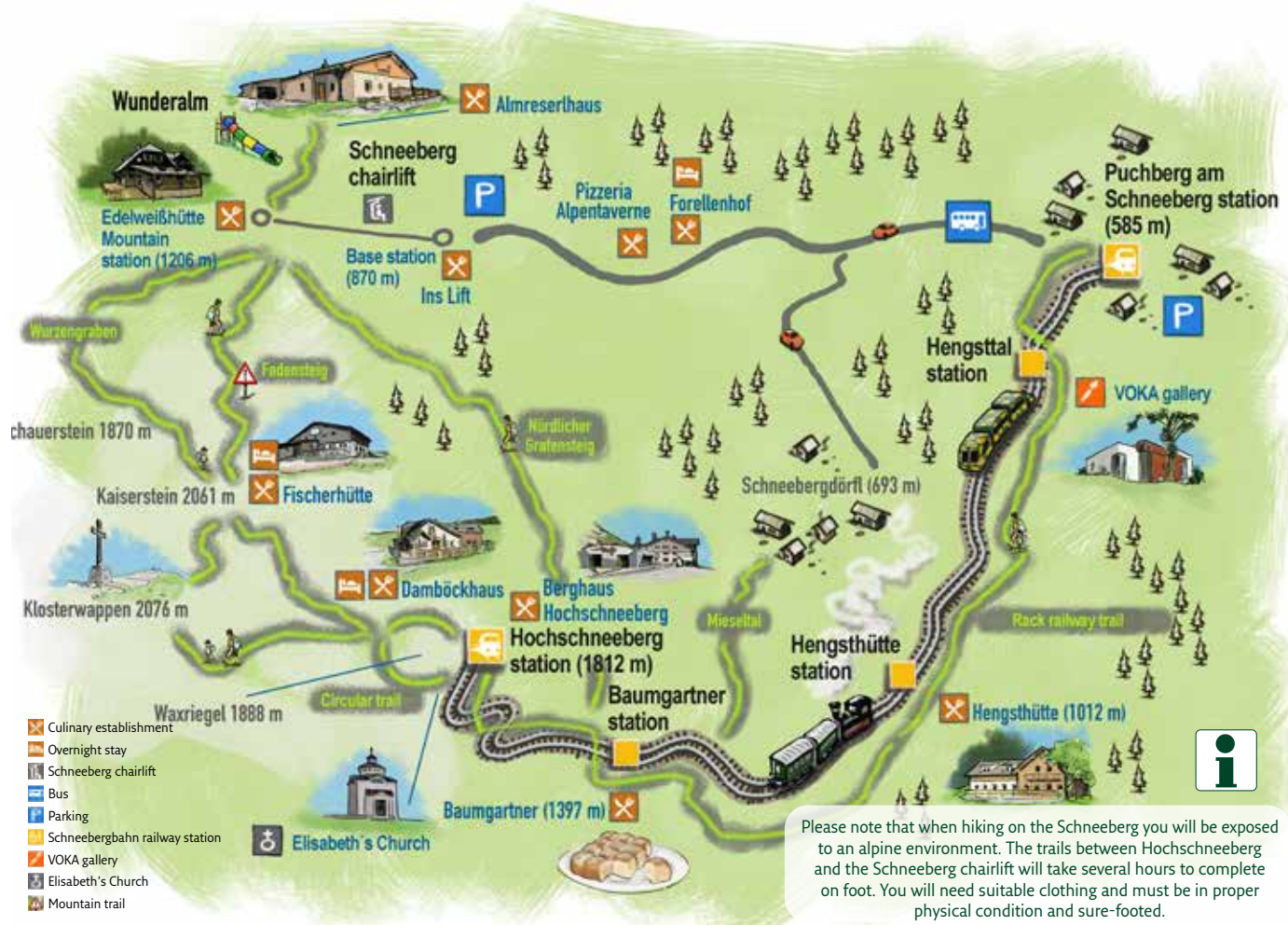

A mountain and natural adventure playground

THE HOCHSCHNEEBERG MOUNTAIN
A place to arrive, play and spend time: Activity and fun on the Salamander playground while contemplation and respite can be found in the little Elisabeth's Church and the Salamanderplatz and Kaiserrast areas.

SALAMANDERPLATZ AND KAISSERRAST
Catch your breath and relax on the seating on these extensive rest areas while taking in the unique views.

ELISABETH'S CHURCH
Emperor Franz Joseph I commissioned the construction of the Elisabeth's Church in 1901 as a memorial to his assassinated wife, Empress Elisabeth. It was built using stones from the Schneeberg in Art Nouveau style. Mountain masses, baptisms and marriages continue to be conducted here.

SALAMANDER PLAYGROUND
Here bigger kids can let off steam and play in the rope jungle while there is also a playground for the little ones; this the highest located playground in Lower Austria!

ALPINE SUNRISE EVERY FRIDAY FROM JULY 7 TO AUGUST 25

Arrive on the highest mountain in Lower Austria before dawn and experience the breathtaking sunrise with a unique view of the Vienna Basin and the Pannonian lowlands at 1,800 meters above sea level. Then take the Salamander train in comfort or a sporty walk down the valley to the Baumgartner station, where a hearty mountain breakfast awaits you. Afterwards you can start the early descent, or enjoy the magic of the mountain in the morning for a few more hours, head back to the Hochschneeberg mountain station and use any descent until 11:45 a.m.

The Schneeberg – a paradise for hikers

With over 80 km of hiking and alpine trails, Puchberg is among the loveliest hiking areas in Lower Austria. The Hochschneeberg mountain station is the ideal starting point for numerous adventurous hikes on and around the Schneeberg!

PLATEAU TRAIL
Starting at the mountain station, this 7 km moderately difficult trail leads to the summit of the Schneeberg at an elevation of 2076 m.a.s.l. (duration: 2.5 - 3 hours). The Fischerhütte lodge provides all creature comforts.

ZAHNRADBAHN TRAIL
This roughly 10 km long, moderately difficult trail also starts at the mountain station of the Schneeberg railway. The trail runs via Baumgartner station, the Kaltwassersattel, the Hengsthütte and the Hauslitzsattel down to Puchberg on the Schneeberg (duration: 3 hours)
